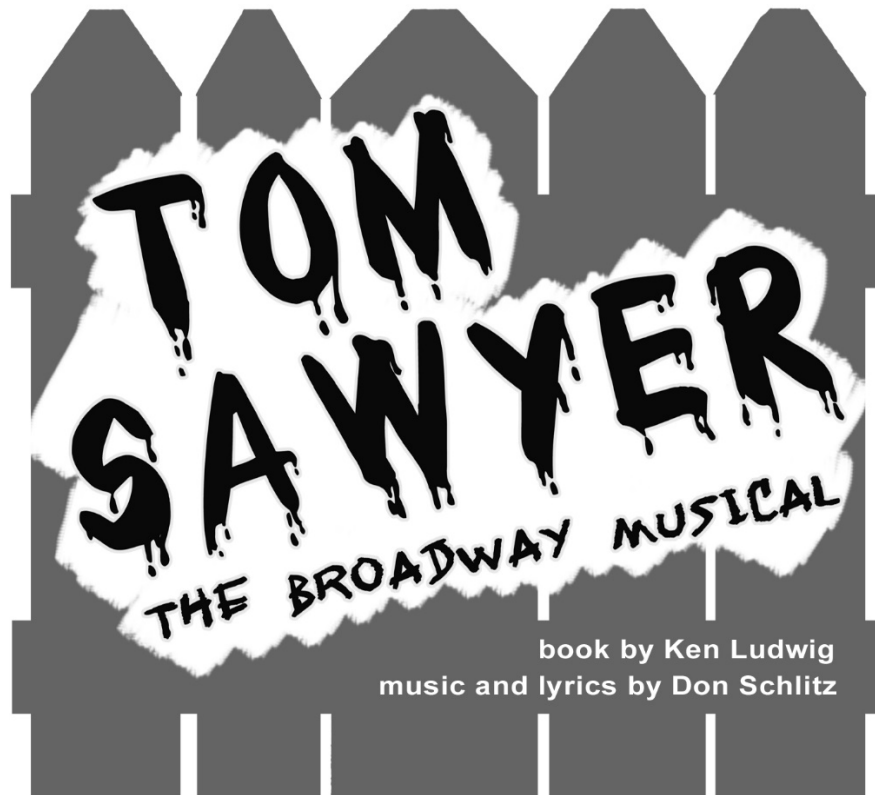

Director's Notes

When thinking of Tom Sawyer, the images that come to mind are those of boyhood, summertime fun and innocent mischief. But the brilliance of Mark Twain created a story in which boyhood and manhood merge in the title character's life experiences. Tom is a carefree, heedless, and adventure loving youth in Twain's "hymn to boyhood." But even as Tom's imagination runs wild and he is bored with his common lot in life, he slowly comes to realize that with adventure come some hard realities, and that being a hero isn't always as glamorous as it seems. Tom grows from a boy to a man when he puts aside his habitually lying ways to stand up in court and tell the truth to save Muff Potter's life. Tom becomes even more of a man when he discovers that some of the greatest adventures can, and do happen closest to home, and are not as fun as they seem in his books. The story of Tom Sawyer is one we should all learn from: live a youthful and joyful life, but don't be afraid to stand up for what is right when the time comes, and don't get so busy searching for adventure elsewhere that you miss out on the beauty and the gift of the life you are currently living.
